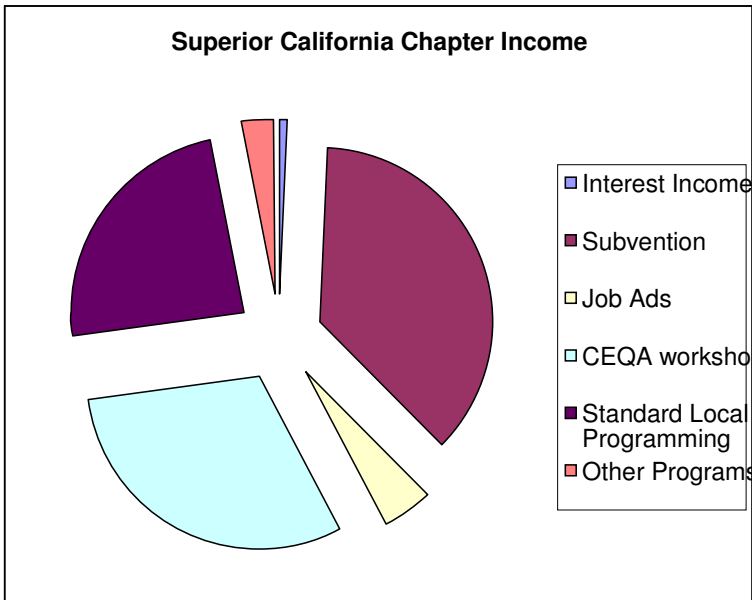

## The NEWS from your Treasurer

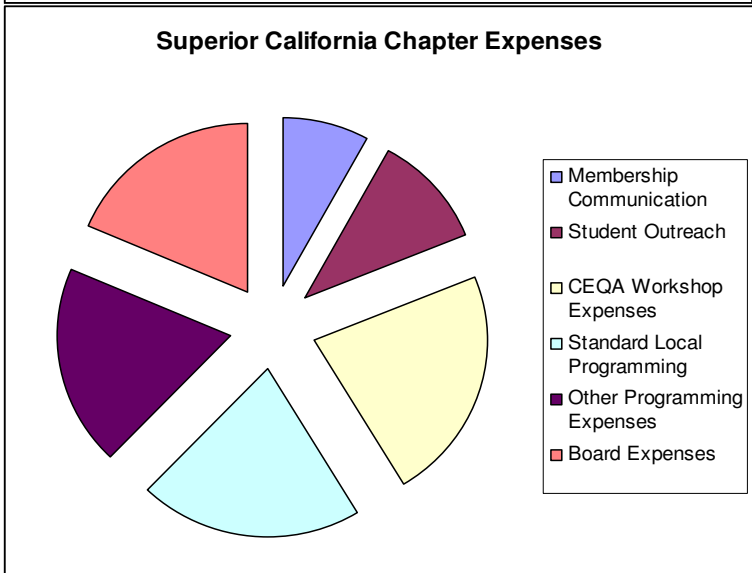
The local AEP chapters are required to prepare a budget for each fiscal year, which runs from January 1 through December 31. At our November board meeting, we drafted a budget for the upcoming fiscal year based on the current year's income and expenses, changing allocations as necessary. The budget was approved at our December board meeting.



The Chapter receives 25 percent of your annual membership dues in the form of subventions from the AEP State Board. In addition to subventions, we receive income from job ads placed on our website (<http://superioraep.org/>) and from money we make on programs including the CEQA workshops and other local events (lunch and social programs). We try to break even on those local events.

With the income we have, the Chapter funds the following:

- Membership outreach, primarily through the upkeep of our website
- Student outreach (student scholarships)
- CEQA workshop expenses
- Standard local programming expenses (lunch programs)
- Other programming expenses (mixers or other social programs)
- Board expenses (funds for our monthly board meetings and to cover our Chapter Director's attendance at the quarterly state board meetings)
