Nationwide Permits Update

Presenter: Nancy Haley of the Army Corps of Engineers

On March 12, 2007, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) reissued all existing Nationwide Permits (NWP), general conditions, and definitions, with some modifications. Additionally, the Corps issued six new NWPs, two new general conditions, and 13 new definitions. Please join the Association of Environmental Professionals for a presentation of these changes by Nancy Haley with the Regulatory Branch of the Sacramento District of the Corps.

Nancy will be discussing these changes and what they mean to the wetland permitting process in the Sacramento area. Specifically, she will provide an overview of the following:

- Modifications to existing permits and general conditions including NWPs 29 and 39.
- Acreage limits and pre-construction notification thresholds.
- A brief overview of the new nationwide permits and general conditions.
- A discussion of when and how the Sacramento Regulatory Branch will be implementing these new NWPs, following approval from the State Water Resources Control Board.

Speaker Biography: Nancy Haley is a Regulatory Project Manager with the Corps. She has over 15 years of experience with the Regulatory Branch of the Sacramento District of the Corps, where she evaluates projects under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act. Nancy and Jason Gipson are heading a team to write the Supplemental Decision Documents for Sacramento District to address the Regional Conditions and cumulative effects of the new NWPs. Nancy is currently working in a Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) funded position and is the office chief for the Funded By Others office in the Central California/Nevada Office. She teaches Endangered Species Act and Essential Fish Habitat classes for the national training branch of the Corps.

Directions:

From Interstate 5 take the J Street exit toward Downtown. Turn right at 3rd Street and then make a right onto the CA-275 ramp to San Francisco (follow the signs to Old Sacramento). Merge onto Capitol Mall. Turn right on Front Street. The Delta King is located at the corner of Front and K Streets.

Parking:

There are two parking garages in Old Sacramento: 1) at the corner of Capitol Mall and Front Streets and 2) at 3rd and J Streets. The Delta King is a few minutes walk from each of the garages. Valet Parking is available at the Delta King and metered parking is available on the street; however, space is limited.
