Large scale wind turbine generation projects pose special challenges for wildlife surveys, bird and bat mortality estimating and monitoring and operations which are addressed by a number of new industry guidelines. Bruce Webb, Staff Environmental Scientist from the Department of Fish and Game, Northern Region in Redding, will give a presentation on the Hatchet Ridge Wind Turbine Project in Shasta County. Due to the potential for mortality to certain birds, innovations in mitigation and monitoring were devised for this project.

Mr. Webb has been with the Department of Fish and Game for 8 years. He has approximately 30 years experience in CEQA review, large scale project management and natural and biological resource management.
