SPEAKER: Tina Bartlett, Branch Chief, Habitat Conservation Planning Branch

Tina oversees the California Department of Fish and Game's (CDFG) Habitat Conservation Planning Branch. The Branch includes the Environmental Review and Permitting Programs including CEQA, CESA, and Lake and Streambed Alteration; Invasive Species Program; Natural Community Conservation Planning and Mitigation Banking Program; and a new Voluntary Conservation Incentives Program. The Branch creates and communicates the Department's statewide policies and guidance in these program areas, develops and improves conservation tools, provides outreach and education, creates and fosters collaborative partnerships, and provides Region support. Tina has been with the Department for over 10 years. Prior to working for the Department, Tina worked as a private consulting biologist for 6 years in forested landscapes in northern California and Oregon.

TOPIC: Tina's lunch presentation will cover CDFG's work and efforts in Natural Community Conservation and Habitat Conservation Planning; Lake and Streambed Alteration; Endangered Species permitting; strategies for advanced mitigation; streamlined permitting; and consolidated mitigation.
